



Conditions of Entry

Welcome to Beatty Park Leisure Centre

In the interest of all visitors the following conditions of entry apply

Access to Facilities

Management reserves the right to adjust availability and access to facilities within the Centre without notice.

Adult Entry Price

Customers 16 years and over are required to pay adult entry prices, unless an appropriate concession card is shown at the time of entry.

Concession Entry Fees

Concession entry is available for holders of a current Government Pension Card, Veterans' Affairs Card or Seniors' Card. Cards must be presented and other identification may be requested.

Spectator Fees

Are charged to any non swimming adult aged 16 years and over entering the Centre.

Members' Access

Members must have their membership cards with them to gain access to the Centre. Casual entry prices may be charged to members that cannot produce a current membership card.

Admission of Carers of People with Special Needs

Carers for people with special needs will be granted free access to the Centre when accompanied by a person with special needs. The carer must stay and look after their charge at all times whilst in the Centre.

Supervision of Children – Watch Around Water

All children under 5 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible adult who stays in the pool within arm's reach of the child at all times.

All children between 5 and 12 years of age must be accompanied and supervised by a guardian over 16 years of age.

Parents/Supervisors cannot attend the gym/spa/group fitness classes etc and leave children unsupervised in the Centre at any time.

Consumption of Alcohol

Is not permitted within the Centre or grounds without the express permission of the Centre Management.

Aqua Nappies

Babies or young children that would ordinarily wear a nappy for any part of their day, must wear an aqua nappy when in and around all aquatic facilities within the Centre.

(ordinance 4 1 24e HEALTH (AQUATIC FACILITIES) REGULATIONS 2007)

Contagious Infections

Entry will not be allowed for people who appear to be suffering from any contagious, infectious, coetaneous disease or complaint.

People who have had diarrhoea in the past two weeks shall not enter any water body.

Eviction Schedule

The Centre has an eviction schedule for customers who have breached Conditions of Entry. All breaches are recorded.

Mobile Phones

Mobile phones/cameras cannot be used for any purpose while in the changing rooms or toilet facilities within the Centre.

Bikes, Scooters, Skateboards and Rollerblades Inside the Centre

None of the above are to be brought into the Centre or left in the foyer. Bike racks are available outside the entrance and under the grandstand steps in the car park.

Lost Property

Unclaimed lost property will be disposed of to a local charity after 3 months.

No responsibility will be taken for any belongings brought into or left at the Centre at any time. The use of lockers is highly recommended.

Keep Your Centre Beautiful

Please put your rubbish in the bins provided.

Suitable Attire

Swimmers are required to wear recognisable bathing attire in the pool and spa. Gym clients are required to wear appropriate gym wear, closed in shoes and have a towel during workouts.

No Glass or Sharp Objects

Entry will not be granted to people carrying glass containers or any object that is not required for a constructive use within the Centre.

No Smoking

In the interests of comfort and safety, smoking is not permitted within the indoor or outdoor areas of the Centre.

Under the Influence of Alcohol & Other Drugs

Entry will not be granted to people who are or appear to be under the influence of alcohol or prohibited drugs.

(ordinance 1a(iv) TOWN OF VINCENT LOCAL GOVERNMENT PROPERTY LOCAL LAW 2008)

No Person Shall

- Consume foodstuffs or drinks in any specific area in which food and drink consumption is prohibited.
- Use soap or shampoo in any part of the pool premises other than in a change-room.
- Use any detergent or any substance or oil in any pool or spa area within the pool premises.
- Spit or expectorate in any part of a community facility, other than in a water closet.

Private Swim Coaching in Centre

As we have our own swim school and coaches within the Centre, private coaching of students is not permitted.

Rights of Others within the Centre

Customers are reminded to respect the rights of other patrons to use and enjoy the Centre.

Risk and Liability

Customers are reminded that at any time whilst they are on the premises, loss or damage to both property and person shall be at their own risk. City of Vincent, its employees and agents are not liable for any injury or loss of property however caused, whether negligent or otherwise.

Security Cameras

The Centre has both video and still surveillance cameras operating at all times. Entry into the Centre gives Management the right to use images taken for security and investigation purposes.
