



Conditions of Entry

Welcome to Beatty Park Leisure Centre

In the interest of all visitors the following conditions of entry apply

Access and Entry

By entering this facility you indemnify the City and its officers, agents and employees in respect of any event which may occur whilst present at the Centre and any event which results in any damage to property or any accident, injury or loss being suffered or occasioned to you or any person in your care and control to the fullest extent permissible at law, hereby release the City from liability unless the injury sustained is as a result of the City's negligence.

You acknowledge and recognise the possibility of injury or other damages connected with physical activity usually undertaken by yourself or any person under your care whilst using the facilities or services and hereby release the City from liability unless the injury sustained is as a result of the City's negligence.

Management reserves the right to adjust availability and access to facilities within the centre without notice.

Customers 16 years and over are required to pay adult entry prices, unless an appropriate concession card is shown at the time of entry.

Concession entry is available for holders of a current Government Pension Card, Veterans' Affairs Card or Seniors Cards. Cards must be presented and other identification may be requested.

Carers will be granted complimentary access to the centre when accompanying a person with special needs. The carer is to be responsible for the person in their care at all times whilst in the centre.

Members must present their membership card to gain access to the centre via the turnstiles or they will be required to check in at the Reception counter.

Abusive and antisocial behaviour will not be tolerated and offenders may be asked to leave.

Appropriate dress is required at all time, this means swimmers are required to wear bathing attire in the pool and spa areas. Gym and Fitness class patrons are required to wear gym wear, closed in shoes and have a towel during workouts.

Bike racks are available outside the entrance and a secure bike locker is also available (details available at Reception) for your convenience.

Watch Around Water

Children under 5 years of age must be accompanied by an adult who stays in the pool within arm's reach of the child at all times.

All children between 5 – 12 years of age must be accompanied and supervised by a guardian over 16 years of age.

Safety, Health and Hygiene

This is a smoke free facility, including the car park and within 15 meters of any part of the building

Entry will not be granted to people who are, or appear to be, under the influence of alcohol or prohibited drugs.

Consumption of alcohol is not permitted within the centre or grounds without the express permission of the centre management.

Babies or young children that would ordinarily wear a nappy for any part of their day, must wear an aqua nappy when in and around all aquatic facilities within the centre.

Parents/Supervisors cannot attend the gym/spa/group fitness classes and leave children under 12 unsupervised in the centre at any time.

Entry will not be allowed for people who appear to be suffering from any gastrointestinal disease, skin infection or other disease that is communicable. Prior to entry you may be asked by staff to present a written letter from a medical practitioner to confirm no health hazard is presented from any observed communicable conditions.

Glass is strictly prohibited within the centre and entry will not be granted to people carrying glass containers or water bottles.

Covid safety

You must not visit if you or anyone in your group are unwell and displaying symptoms

- Practice physical distancing with people outside of your family group whilst in the centre
- Practice good personal hygiene whilst in the centre (Wash Hands, Cover Nose & Mouth, Avoid touching face)
- Always use hand sanitiser provided on entry
- Use the hand sanitiser available throughout the centre
- Comply with the maximum capacity requirements of any indoor areas like spa, sauna, steamroom and group fitness rooms
- Please download the SafeWA app and check in at the centre or fill in a manual form and hand to Reception. Members can scan in as normal

Security Cameras, Photos and Filming

The centre has surveillance cameras operating at all times which may be used for security and investigation purposes.

The use of recording devices and cameras for commercial use are prohibited in all areas unless pre-approved by the Centre Manager. The use of these devices by the public is not allowed in or around any changing area.

Customers may be filmed or photographed while in the facility. If the images are to be used for marketing purposes, consent will be sought where customers are clearly identifiable.

Lost property

No responsibility will be taken for any belonging brought into or left at the centre at any time. The use of lockers is highly recommended. Unclaimed lost property will be donated to a local charity after 1 month.
